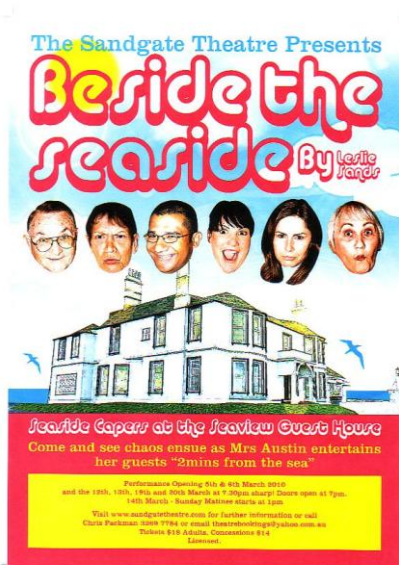

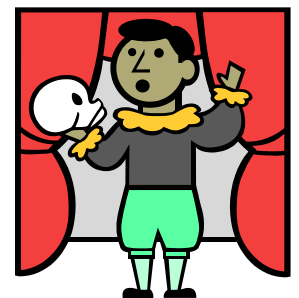
Your committee is busy working towards finding an alternative venue for us while the hall is closed. Any suggestions please contact a committee member.
